

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Stratmoor Hills Water & sanitation district Failure to be Operated by State Certified Operator

Our water system recently violated a drinking water requirement. Although this situation is not an emergency, as our customers you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation.

The state drinking water program requires that all public drinking water systems must be under the direct supervision of a certified operator at the appropriate certification level. We have received a violation because our water system is not being operated by a state certified operator at the appropriate level.

What does this mean? What should I do?

- There is nothing you need to do at this time. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, you will be notified within 24 hours.

What is being done?

- 4-29-25 to 5-13-25 was without a orc as of 5-13-25 we have a orc. During the dates we had no registered ORC or listed operator in charge of our water treatment plant. All treatment processes were continued safely through the guidance of our approved s.o.ps. No adverse health effects or violations at this time. Consumers need to take no other actions at this time. we are now in compliance with an ORC please contact Stratmoor hills water and sanitation district. Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses).
